Taking the two whole matzot along with the broken one, we say the following blessing:

בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה יְיָ, אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם,
הַמוֹצִיא לֶחֶם מִן־הָאָרֶץ

*Barukh atah Adonai Eloheynu melekh ha'olam
hamotzi lekhem min ha'aretz.*

Blessed are You, O LORD our God, Ruler of the universe,
who brings forth bread from the earth.

אֲשֶׁר קִדְּשָׁנוּ בְּמִצְוֹתָיו, וְצִוָּנוּ עַל־אֲכִילַת מַצָּה

*Barukh atah Adonai Eloheynu melekh ha'olam
Asher kid'shanu b'mitzvotav v'tzivanu al akhilat matzah.*

Blessed are You, O LORD our God, Ruler of the universe, who sanctified us
with Your commandments, and commanded us to eat unleavened bread.
